tagging pilot projects conducted worldwide have already been written off as failures and most of the rest have yielded indifferent results, according to analyst organisation Meta Group.

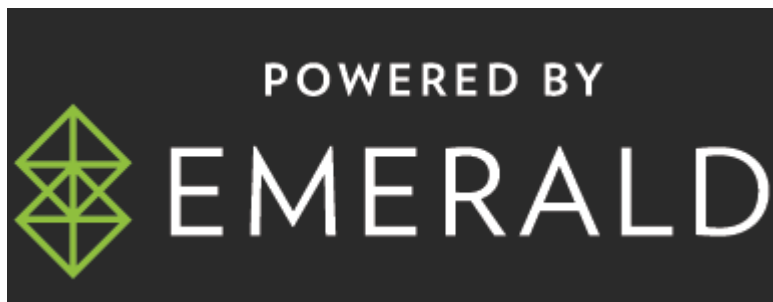
