RFID Journal LIVE! 2016 to Feature Three Co-located Events

RFID Journal announced today that three co-located events will be held in conjunction with this year's RFID Journal LIVE! conference and exhibition, an event focused on radio frequency

The LMC Forum will feature a group of experts presenting on the main uses of RFID across rail operations, passenger support, freight security and intermodal visibility, as well as the
